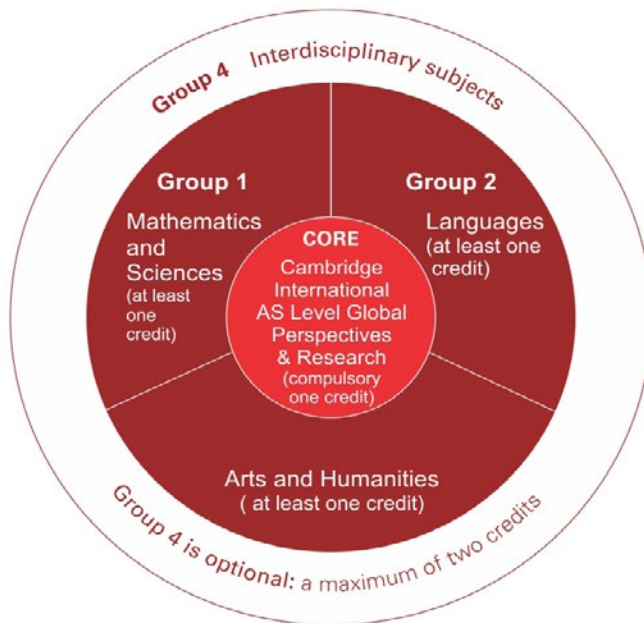

### Cambridge AICE Diploma

The Cambridge AICE Diploma offers breadth across the curriculum and depth in selected subjects.



**Total of seven credits required for Diploma**

Cambridge International AS Level = one credit

Cambridge International A Level = two credits

Learners can accumulate credits for the Diploma over a 25-month period.

Learners will now have to achieve a minimum of seven credits (including Cambridge International AS Level Global Perspectives & Research) from subject groups 1, 2 and 3 (and optionally Group 4) to be awarded the Diploma.

Learners must achieve at least one credit from each of Groups 1, 2 and 3. The remaining credits can come from any of the groups. A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4.

## Cambridge Assessment International Examinations AS and A level

Cambridge Advanced is typically for learners aged 16 to 19 years who need advanced study to prepare for university and higher education.

- **Students are expected to take a minimum of 7 credits including GPR at AS level in order to complete the Cambridge AICE Diploma requirement. If any student wishes to take more than 7 credits, he/she will have to discuss it with the counselor and the coordinator. The subject will then be offered at the school's discretion**
- **Further Mathematics will only be offered to students based on their performance in Additional Math (in IGCSE) and a Pre-assessment.**
- **Legacy will offer exams in March 2020 and March 2021. However, Cambridge offers Computer science and French only in June.**
- **Students may change a subject (only if any) within the first week of Grade 11. Parental consent should be submitted for the same.**

As per the **Association of Indian Universities' (AIU)** letter, a student must have at least **5 passes in IGCSE with Grades of A,B,C or D** and Two (2) / Three (3) passes at the GCE A Level is recognized by AIU as the equivalent of a +2 stage qualification of an Indian Board, thereby granting access to a Bachelor's degree program at Indian Universities.

Students intending to pursue Medical/Engineering degree programs are required to have obtained GCE 'A' Level passes in English, Chemistry, Physics, Biology / Mathematics and Five (5) passes at IGCSE.

Upon the completion of the AS and A level exams, the final report card will comprise of a cumulative report of the student's behavioural and academic progress in the internal assessments, Preliminary examinations conducted in Grade 11 and Cambridge assessment International examinations collectively.

In Grades 11 and 12, students will be expected to meet the established criteria as specified by AIU to continue into the next grade and be eligible for the AS and A level examinations. If the student is unable to achieve an **overall** grade of 'D' or better in each subject the student will be placed on academic probation and will not be allowed to appear / be registered for the CAIE examinations through the school.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- AS Level is equivalent to Grade 11 and a student would be eligible to earn 1 credit upon completion of the AS Level examination conducted at the end of Grade 11
- A Level is equivalent to Grade 12 and a student would be eligible to earn 2 credits upon completion of the A Level examination conducted at the end of Grade 12
- Leading universities across Indian and worldwide value and recognize Cambridge qualifications as evidence of academic ability. View details by country and qualification :

- As per the Association of Indian Universities, 2/3 passes at GCE A Level of the approved British Examining Bodies has been equated with Grade 12 of an Indian Board, which is minimum eligibility requirement for admission to Bachelor Degree Programs at Indian Universities. Candidates intending to join Medical/Engineering degree programs are required to have obtained Advanced level (A Level) passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and English at AS Level.

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5. As per the Association of Indian Universities, English at AS Level, which is conducted by one of the approved British Examining Bodies, is acceptable as an English language qualification for admissions to Medical/Engineering degree programs at the universities within India.
6. Art & Design offers several areas of study; at Legacy we offer Graphic Design, Paint and related media.
7. Cambridge AICE Diploma with Distinction is awarded to students with a score of 360 points or above
8. Cambridge AICE Diploma with Merit is awarded to students with a score between 250 and 359 points
9. Cambridge AICE Diploma at Pass level is awarded to students with between 140 and 249 points
10. Policy for change of subjects:  
AS Level & IBDP: Students will have the 1st 3 weeks to finalise their subjects. No change will be made post this period.
11. Exam Series :  
AS & A Level : Students take up external exams in the February-March series  
IBDP : Students take up external exams in March, at the end of the 2nd year
