The aim of the Legacy School Scholarship program is to recognize exceptional talent and cultivate excellence. Our objective is to provide an exclusive opportunity that will empower deserving students to develop as well-rounded individuals and benefit from the vibrant learning environment while pursuing an internationally recognized high school qualification.

These prestigious scholarships are reserved for the highest achieving and most deserving learners who have demonstrated outstanding Academic Achievement, and have been actively involved in School Life and Citizenship, or excelled in areas of Leadership, Technology and Entrepreneurship.

Legacy School will award scholarships to eligible Grade 9 applicants seeking admission to the Cambridge IGCSE qualification. Students can apply for and be considered for either a full (100%) or part (25% - 75%) merit-based tuition scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:

- Scholarships are offered at the sole discretion of Legacy School and the School reserves the right to modify or retract the offer at its discretion and without prior notice
- The number of scholarships awarded varies each year and will depend on the suitability and number of candidates who qualify
- Submission of this application does not construe or confirm the granting of the Scholarship
- Scholarships are open to Grade 9 applicants seeking admission to the Cambridge IGCSE qualifications
- Scholarships are determined in an open competition, at a fixed level set by the School, and are non-negotiable
- The decision of the Scholarship Committee will be final and binding
- Scholarship recipients will be expected to meet certain guidelines on student participation and achievement, as and when prescribed by the School, in order to continue receiving the scholarship benefit
- All Scholarships are reviewed by the Scholarship Review Committee on a quarterly basis to assure that attainment and commitments are being maintained at the standard expected of an academic scholar
- Scholarships may be withdrawn at any time if a scholar does not maintain the expected standards or is in violation of school policy

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SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Scholarships are awarded in Grade 9 and continue in Grade 10, but are subject to review of student progress and achievement.
- The Scholarship program is available to all new students, who wish to enroll in the Cambridge IGCSE program in the academic year 2019-20
- Learners should have completed Grade 8 with a minimum grade of A or 90% or have national level achievement in the area chosen. (The decision on the minimum equivalent grade for students applying from different curriculums / grading systems rests solely with the Legacy School Scholarship Committee)
- Learners who have a parent or guardian employed by a company that pays / reimburses the school fee of their employees' children are not eligible to apply for the Scholarship
- Selection for the Scholarship will be based on the personal statement, evidence of the criteria specified in the application and a personal interview with the Scholarship Review Committee.
- Personal statement: A 350-500 words persuasive statement reflecting upon the applicant's eligibility to be considered for and awarded the Scholarship in the area chosen.
- Enrollment and scholarship will be confirmed only after the completion of all admission formalities
- Written Round: Applicants will answer a logical thinking test.
